This is to certify that Thomas Court has appeared before us the
Board of Land Commissioners for the County of Jefferson and proved
according to law that he arrived in this country in one thousand
eight hundred twenty nine, and that he is a married man and enti-
tled to one League and labor of land upon the condition of paying
at the rate of three dollars 50 cts for every labor of Triggable
land, two dollars 50 cts for every labor of Temporal or Arable
land, one dollar 25 cts for every labor of Pasture land which
may be contained in the survey secured to him by this certifi-
cate
