

Wyatt Stubblefield to John Stubblefield ^{Acres} 164. 137

This Indenture made this fifteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred of seventy five between Wyatt Stubblefield of the county of Orange Province of North Carolina of the one part & John Stubblefield of Guilford County of Province aforesaid of the other part Witnesses that for & in consideration of the sum of ninety pounds to him in hand paid the receipt whereof he the said Wyatt do hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained & sold aliened enfeoffed released & confirmed unto the said John Stubblefield his heirs & assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land & premises situate being & lying in the County of Guilford of Orange & in the Province aforesaid & on the North side of Hogans beginning at a M. O. running thence S. 75 Degrees N. 111 poles to a R. O. thence N. 215 poles to a M. O. thence E. 128 poles to a Hickory in said Wyatts Spring branch thence E. 78 degrees S. down said branch 30 poles to a Maple thence E. down said branch 21 poles to a Plum-tree on the creek bank thence up the said Hogans creek by the meadows of the water course to the beginning containing one hundred of sixty four acres of one hundred of thirty seven poles be the same more or less & also the recreation & diversions remainder & remainders all houses outhouses orchards & rents & services thereof & also the estate right title interest claim & demand of him the said Wyatt of in & to the said land & premises & of every part & parcel thereof To have & to hold the said tract or parcel of land & premises above mentioned with the appurtenances unto the said John Stubblefield his heirs & assigns forever of the Wyatt Stubblefield & for himself his heirs & assigns & of them doth covenant & grant unto the said John Stubblefield his heirs & assigns forever the said tract or parcel of land above mentioned & every part & parcel thereof against him the said Wyatt his heirs & assigns & against all & every other person whatsoever saying any claim thereunto only he the said John Stubblefield his heirs or assigns shall with warrant & force defend by these presents In Witness whereof the said Wyatt Stubblefield hath hereunto sett his hand & affixed his seal the day & year above written
