This INDUMENT made this twelfth day of October in the year of our Lord
one thousand seven hundred & seventy two between Thomas Jepsope son & wife of the County of
Guilford in the Province of North Carolina of the one Part & David Macy of the aforesaid Province
& County of the other Part witnesseth that the said Thomas Jepsope & wife for the Consideration
of the sum of one hundred & fifty Pounds Proclamation Money to them in hand paid before the
enfealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Thomas Jepsope & wife doth
hersby acknowledge & doth fully discharge the said David Macy of his heirs & of hath granted her-
gained sold in fee simple confirmed by these Presents doth grant bargain sell in fee simple confirmed
unto the said David Macy his heirs & assigns one certain tract of land containing two
hundred & twenty two acres be it more or less two hundred acres of the above said tract
the said Thomas Jepsope bought of James Brittain Sen^r the Head bearing date one thousand seven
hundred & eighty eight it being part of a tract of land granted the said James Brittain Sen^r
by the Earl of Granville's Agent by Deed bearing date one thousand seven hundred & eighty eight
the other twenty two acres of land the said Thomas Jepsope bought of Zacharias Dicks the
Deed bearing date one thousand seven hundred & eighty eight the whole tract of two hundred
of twenty two acres of land situated lying & being on Persipine Creek in the aforesaid County
being bounded as follows to wit beginning at a small White Oak near a large Poplar tree
on Balipes Branch on Zacharias Dicks line of runs thence N. 72 Deg. E. 70 Poles to a White
Oak thence N. 60 Deg. W. 72 Poles to a Stake to the left end of James Brittain's line thence
N. 26 Deg. W. 22 Poles to the mouth of the said Pitt Branch thence up said Branch to the
fountain head from thence the same general course of the Branch until it joins with
the line of the whole tract thence E. 232 Poles to a Black Oak thence south 83 Poles
to a Black Oak thence S. 36 Deg. E. 148 Poles to a Pine thence east 42 Poles to the
left Station & together with the Ringer fence of all other appurtenances hereto belonging
